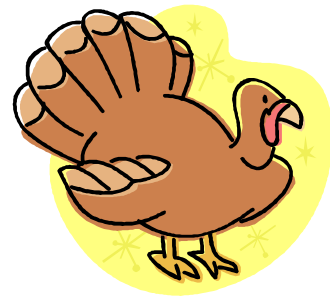


# November News
