Religion:

We learned how God's fairness isn't the same as ours. We also looked at the life of Saint Francis de Sales and learned how he taught that everyone can lead holy lives.

Reading/Language Arts:

In Reading, we read chapters 5+6 in *Tales of a Fourth Grade Nothing*. Peter helped his mom throw a party for his brother in chapter 5. Chapter 6 took us on adventures through town.

In Language Arts, we identified pronouns, classified them as singular or plural, and identified and used subject pronouns.

Vocabulary:

We are midway through our Vocabulary curriculum. Students will have a test covering chapters 1-9 on Tuesday of next week.

Math: Students learned the meaning and the rules of division. We used inverse operations to find related multiplication and division facts. (See pages 164-167 for review.)

Science/Social Studies:

In Social Studies: We began learning about the Northeastern United States. Students created travel guides about products, resources, foods, and climate in this region.

In Science, students sorted animals into groups based on similar characteristics. We began learning about vascular and non-vascular plants.
